

# LWCCG GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES FOR WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 21, 2021

Gene opened the meeting at 7:00pm. He told members that since our last meeting he suffered a heart attack and has a pace maker now. He said he will have to give up his position as president, but would still like to work for the club.

Since we have not had a show in two years, Gene said he would like to announce the member of the year here at our meeting. He then presented the award to Mitch Pivach thanking him for the many years he has been working for our club.

Chris Weaver brought up the positions we have open now to fill for officers and suggested we list them in the next newsletter. The nominations are taken starting in January and the election will be held at the February general meeting. This will give everyone time to think about running for an open position, (See information in this newsletter)

Gene said that Harvey Lewis called him and said he is looking for a place for his collection of decoys and wanted to ask for some help from anyone in finding one.

The Louisiana Sportsman show has one here and two in Mississippi. We have done pretty good in the past there. ( Ralph and Fred go). Gene mentioned that Kathy would like to step down from the position of Secretary if anyone is interested in filling the position.

Chris Weaver brought up our next show and made a suggestion of having the show without competition. It was discussed and one member said he didn't think that the show would survive without a competition Richard and Gene agreed.

Emile asked to be recognized and said he wanted to thank Gene, who has been president since he joined the club.

Gene told members that since we decided to have an early show in 2022, after cancelling 2021 because of Ida, we met with the Castine Center to see what was available.
